

## Sleep Technicians Wanted

The Sleep Disorders Centre at the Princess Alexandra Hospital is a NATA accredited laboratory that manages all manner of complex sleep and ventilatory disorders. In-lab sleep studies are conducted seven nights per week.

We currently require a casual sleep technician to work a combination of set-up (6.30pm to 11.45pm) and overnight shifts (11.15 pm to 7.15am) on a weekly basis. Experience will be looked upon favourably. Comprehensive training (paid) will be provided to obtain the skills needed to carry out the tasks according to laboratory requirements. The applicants must be able to participate in biennial training weeks (held in 1<sup>st</sup> weeks of January and mid-August).

### Duties include:

- Overnight monitoring of patients undergoing sleep investigations
- Interpretation of physiological signals during investigations
- Recognition and troubleshooting of equipment faults
- Introduction and adjustment of treatment modalities
- Participation in continuous improvement and professional development activities

### Qualifications:

- Relevant tertiary degree or equivalent with a strong component in physiology

### Remuneration:

- Pay is in the HP2 scale (\$29.73-\$41.32 per hour with 15% casual & 15% night loading)
- Starting increment level will be decided by experience and qualifications
