- The set-up and maintenance of nocturnal ventilatory support (CPAP/BiPAP/ASV) for patients with sleep disordered breathing

- Certification/Registration examination BRPT (or agreed other) or working towards BRPT
- Availability to work overnight on an ongoing basis as per roster
- Experience in the field of Sleep Physiology is desirable but not essential
